QUEENSLAND HEALTH OPERATIONAL WORKERS EB11 - COST OF LIVING ADJUSTMENT (COLA)

As part of the Department's offer to operational workers, Queensland Health is offering a Cost of Living Adjustment (also known as a COLA).

This COLA is an additional increase to your base rate that occurs if inflation is higher than your wage increase in the March financial quarter of each year of the agreement (2022-23, 2023-24 and 2024-5).

The measure of this inflation is the Consumer Price Index, which measures changes in the price of household goods and services like food, clothing and transport.

If the Consumer Price Index in the March financial quarter is higher than the wage increase for that year, the COLA will be activated and you will receive a one-off payment based on the difference up to a cap of 3%.

Example #1: if the CPI in the March quarter is 5% and the wage increase from the Department is 4%, the COLA will activate and you will receive a one-off payment of 1% of your base rate for that twelve month period.

Example #2: if the CPI in the March quarter is 6% and the wage increase from the Department is 4%, the COLA will activate and you will receive a one-off payment of 2% of your base rate for that twelve month period.

Example #3: if the CPI in the March quarter is 7% and the wage increase from the Department is 4%, the COLA will activate and you will receive a one-off payment of 3% of your base rate for that twelve month period.

Example #4: if the CPI in the March quarter is 8% and the wage increase from the Department is 4%, the COLA will activate and you will receive a one-off payment of 3% of your base rate for that twelve month period (the COLA is capped at 3%).
